

## ACT ART GALLERY SHOWCASES LOCAL CERAMICS IN TRANSFORMATION – FRASER VALLEY POTTERS GUILD

## Exhibition is the Fourth of Five Planned for the 2022/23 Season of Visual Arts

**MAPLE RIDGE, March 2, 2023** – On Saturday, March 4 from 2pm-4 pm, The ACT Art Gallery will open *Transformation*, a juried exhibition of ceramics created by members of the Fraser Valley Potters Guild.

Each year, the FVPG presents a juried exhibition to showcase a strong collection of their members' recent works. *Transformation* takes inspiration from the miraculous process and specialized skill that transforms clay to object. While potters today have access to new technologies that assist their craft, the basis for their creativity is rooted in the ancient inherent potential of clay.

The works in *Transformation* include both functional and decorative works, showcasing the diversity of techniques and individual character of each of the 34 artists. Many of the works will be available for purchase, and the exhibition will feature a 'mug wall' of unique coffee mugs or tea bowls from each artist.

The timing of this exhibition coincides with the Canadian Clay Symposium at the Shadbolt Centre for the Arts in Burnaby, BC, which takes place on March 25, 2023.

"I'm excited to have the Fraser Valley Potters Guild return to The ACT Art Gallery. As the ACT's own ceramic studio is flourishing, I know the Maple Ridge arts community will enjoy seeing diverse work created by Lower Mainland potters" says Courtney Miller, Curator and Gallery Manager.

The Fraser Valley Potters Guild is a non-profit association with close to 100 members, residing between Yarrow and Richmond. Formed in 1975 by alumni of the Ceramics Department of Douglas College (Surrey Campus), it is now an Association connected to the Kwantlen Polytechnic University Ceramics Department.

The Opening Reception on March 4 is a free event open to the public, and the exhibition will run through April 29, 2023. The ACT Art Gallery is open Tuesday – Saturday, 10am-4pm and on selected evenings.
