

## ACT ART GALLERY SHOWCASES LOCAL PAINTERS IN *CLOSE TO HOME* – GARIBALDI ART CLUB

## Exhibition is the Fifth of Five Planned for the 2022/23 Season of Visual Arts

**MAPLE RIDGE, April 27, 2023** – On Saturday, May 6 from 2pm - 4pm, The ACT Art Gallery will open *Close to Home*, a juried exhibition of paintings created by members of the Garibaldi Art Club.

Each year, the Garibaldi Art Club presents a juried exhibition to showcase a strong collection of their members' recent works. This year's theme, *Close to Home*, reflects the current chapter of emerging from a prolonged pandemic period of staying "close to home".

Garibaldi Art Club President Diane Speirs explains, "over the past couple of years, our artists had social limitations, with some members taking to the outdoors to paint, and others having a creative block. Our shared experience was being 'Close to Home' as our worlds were smaller and more intimate, appreciating beauty around us."

In this exhibition, Garibaldi members share their unique experiences and interpretations of the theme. Working in the medium of paint, artworks include topics such as retreating from the outside world, spending time with family, reviving old pastimes, or finding rejuvenation outdoors through walking, gardening, and exploring natural beauty in our local landscapes.

"The Garibaldi Art Club's 2023 juried exhibition responds aptly to the pandemic period we've all experienced in the last few years. *Close to Home* is a great opportunity for the Garibaldi Art Club to gather and showcase to the community what they've been working on during time spent apart" says Courtney Miller, Curator and Gallery Manager.

Since 1959, The Garibaldi Art Club has organized Maple Ridge artists together to hone their artistic skills primarily in the medium of paint. With a current membership of 72 artworks, the group exhibits artwork several times each year in Maple Ridge and beyond.

The Opening Reception on May 6 is a free event open to the public, and the exhibition will run through June 24, 2023. The ACT Art Gallery is open Tuesday – Saturday, 10am-4pm and on selected evenings.
